- 3. Why did many of the land-based empires we discussed in this unit decline or even collapse in the 1750-1900 time period?
- 4. In reference to the previous question, what specific steps could land-based empires in the 1450-1750 time period could have taken to prevent their decline?
- 5. What was the most impactful cause of empire collapse in the 1450-1750 time period? Support your response with evidence.
- 6. Most of the land-based empires did not industrialize effectively in the 1750-1900 time period, why do you think these states failed to industrialize at the same time as Europe?
- 7. Based on what you learned in this unit, what are the most effective ways of addressing cultural, racial, religious diversity within an empire?
- 8. Consider how land-based empires (1450-1750) utilized monumental architecture and art to legitimize political authority. Evaluate the extent to which monumental architecture reinforces or maintains political authority in the 21st century.
- 9. Consider how land-based empires (1450-1750) utilized religion to legitimize political authority. Evaluate the extent to which religion reinforces or maintains political authority in the 21st century.
- 10. Describe the role of tax collection in the maintenance/growth of state power.
- 11. Is it possible to have a powerful and effective state without tax/tribute collection? Explain your answer.
